
Alfred Nobel University Classrooms

The total area of classroom space is approximately 30000 square metres (and that is without the Palace of Students!). The University has well equipped lecture halls with multimedia projectors and interactive whiteboards. In 2003 the Hall of Nobel Prize Winners' in Economics was opened in Ukraine for the first time ever.
